### Overview

Food Depot is a service provided by Central Union Mission to assist individuals who are experiencing economic difficulties. This program is designed for those who are in need on a monthly basis. Each participant will be able to receive food ***twice per month*** according to the Food Depot calendar and assigned day.

### Eligibility

- Driver's License/ Photo Identification
  - Proof of Residency (Lease or Utility Bill)
- Current proof of Income (2 recent pay stubs, food stamps, SSI, etc.)
  - > Subject to household income levels.
- Social Security card or document with SS#
  - Birth certificate for each child under 18

***The listed documents are mandatory to enroll in the program.***

### Purpose

The purpose of Central Union Mission's Food Depot Program is to assist people in the Metropolitan area with their spiritual and physical needs through Christian programs and food distribution.

### Emergency Food

This offer is immediately available for individuals who are in need of food. **Twice a month**, emergency food recipients may come between the hours of 9:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday - Friday.

Consumer may receive **1** food bag per visit.

To qualify for emergency food assistance, individuals **must** have the following:

- A referral from a legitimate agency or Food Depot card
- Photo ID

**Food Depot will follow the Federal Government policy for inclement weather & Holidays. If the Government is closed, so are we!**
