Completed Backpacks

- On the label, check the appropriate box & gender of the backpack and attach the label securely to the handle of the backpack.

- Please sort the school supplies or organize the completed backpacks by grade and gender before delivering.
- Return the filled backpacks and supplies to one of the drop off locations listed below.
