When you sponsor a child at www.missiondc.org/christmas, you automatically receive a suggested gift list, FAQ and instructions. A follow up email will be sent within two business days with your child's information. On Amazon.com, there is a Wish List titled, "Operation Christmas Miracle 2022." Simply pick out the gifts you want to purchase for your child, on the tag indicate the child's name and ID number, it ships directly to us. When using Amazon, please also remember AmazonSmile!

If shipping your gifts, we are unable to confirm delivery, nor accept shipments on weekends, but once received it will be processed and placed in the child's hands. All the gifts go directly to the children! Drop off is Mon-Fri, 9:00am – 3:30pm.

When dropping off gifts, please go to The Family Ministry Center located at 3194 Bladensburg Rd. NE, Suite B, Washington D.C., 20018. **All donations are due by December 12-14, 2022. Distribution to the families begins on December 17.** The time in-between is for our staff to organize and prep every single bag so that NO child is missed! P.S. another way you can help, is by providing gift cards. They are often used for the older children or for children not sponsored who did not receive much from our extra toys' chest.

Christmas Miracle Donor Instructions

Below are the instructions for purchasing and preparing your child's Christmas gifts or toy drive.

1. Purchase your child's *NEW* Christmas gifts. While you are free to purchase whatever gifts you like, our suggested guidelines are:
 - * One Gift Card
 - * Three-five toys/gifts (please refer to the suggested gift list.)
 - * One warm coat for winter (*hat, mittens/gloves, scarf are optional*)

→Do not forget about **AMAZON.COM**, Wish List program. You will find a list under Operation Christmas Miracle 2022. **Please label your gift with child's name and ID #.** *We are unable to confirm delivery, nor accept shipments on weekends. However, once received, it will be processed and placed in the child's hands.*

2. Please **DO NOT** wrap the gifts. Instead, ship the gifts directly to the Family Ministry Center/Christmas, 3194 B-Bladensburg Rd. NE, Washington D.C., 20018. If dropping the gifts off at the Family Ministry Center, bag your gifts together per child and label them by **CHILD'S NAME, GENDER, AGE and ID NUMBER**.
3. If you would like a tax-exempt letter, please scan a copy of all your receipts along with your completed Donor Information Sheet (below) and send it to christmas@missiondc.org. (*Receipts and donor information sheets are **NOT** released to families and kept confidential.*)
4. Christmas gifts should be delivered to **Central Union Mission, Family Ministry Center December 12-14**. **Distribution of gifts to the families begin December 17.** **The Men's Shelter at 65 Massachusetts Ave. NW is not accepting donations at this time.**
